To cope with CI/AE flight cancellation, delay or advance over 3 hours to/from Taiwan affected by Typhoon KRATHON starting from 01OCT24, please be advised of the following handling guidelines.

1. Application:

Passengers who are holding CI/AE valid tickets including BP00 tickets issued on/before 30SEP24with confirmed bookings on affected flights, must submit applications on/before 01JAN25.

2. Not Applicable:

- a. Passengers holding OAL tickets shall comply with OAL's ticket rule.
- b. All DM/ID/AD/GIT tickets are not applicable for the guidelines as below.

3. Provisions of Change:

a. within ticket validity, the fare/tax differences and reissue charge including reissue service charge shall be waived once provided that RBD/Carrier/Routing (Airport) remain unchanged

and the new flight date is within 14 days prior to/after the affected flight.

Note: TPE/TSA/RMQ/KHH are regarded as the same airport. For instance, KHH-HKG v.v. is permitted to change to TPE-HKGv.v.

b. Apart from the provision 3.a., any fare/tax differences incurred by rebooking/rerouting shall be paid by passengers and reissue charge including reissue service charge

shall be waived once. "WEAT19824" shall be annotated in Endorsement Box on new tickets to signify the reason of waiver as mentioned herewith.

4. No Show Fee/Chargeable Seats/Pre-paid EB:

- a. No show fee shall be waived once. In this scenario, please annotate "WEAT19824" in Reason for Change Box while changing the ET coupon status from S to O.
 - b. Chargeable seat EMD shall be refunded.
 - c. Pre-paid EB EMD shall be refunded.

5. Refund:

a. For totally unused tickets: Full refund shall be performed without imposing any

refund charge.

b. For partially used tickets: Refund charge shall be waived, and calculation of residual refund value shall be based on voluntary refund procedures.
